Her start to homeschool was joyous and tearful—joyous because she really delighted in the curriculum, the textbooks, and the way the teachers taught (BJUPress), but tearful because switching from Italian culture and mentality to American is not very easy.

We are planning an October memorial service for Giulia's mom (who passed away a few months ago). We don't know the date yet because we are waiting on the availability of Giulia's sister. We trust it will be an **encouragement to Giulia (and our church family) and a witness to any of her family members** who may come.

Our apartment building may be going through some wonderful renovations (including insulating all outside walls and installing new windows) to aid in the efficiency of energy usage. This would be a big blessing to us. We're **praying that everything moves ahead**.

Please continue to pray for **Ilario to find work, resolution in a counseling situation, the spiritual needs of Simone, permission to enter the hospital, and Rina to put Christ first. We would also love to see people in our city come to faith in Jesus Christ**.
