We stepped out on the balcony at midnight to see the fireworks, but the fog was so thick (very normal here during December) we couldn't see any of them—though we heard enough booms to scare Gabriella. I am thankful that we made it through these parties successfully. **Thank you for your prayers**.

After Tom installed the new microphone and recording system in our church's meeting place, he discovered that there is a significant echo in the recordings. At our annual meeting this month, we voted to look into solutions.

Thanks for your prayers for our apartment building repairs. So far, no work has been started, though we signed paperwork to move forward a step.
