Dear Praying Friends,

The leadership conference that Tom went to in Rome was a good time of fellowship and networking. One particularly helpful contact was made with a Christian publishing house.

Tom did some electrical work to help out several of our neighbors this month—related to the construction work that is ongoing on our apartment building. His skills and helpfulness have given him relationship-building opportunities and some opportunities to talk about why we are here and about our church. **Please pray that we will be diligent in our testimony and that our neighbors will come to Christ.**

We thank God every day that the workers makes progress on our building and continue to **pray that the work (particularly the work that affects our personal apartment) will finish before we leave on furlough** (March 31). The company has not begun to work on any of the flood damage, so that will not be started until sometime after we get back (September 4).

Tom made a trip to Florence with two of our church's young people to visit Lucio (who is living and working there for several months) and to see a soccer match. The two hour train ride up allowed for conversation on the topic of Creation and Evolution. **Pray for the young people, especially Serena, as they are constantly bombarded with this false teaching in school and conversations with friends, that they would know how to respond biblically.**

We continue to study and teach the Bible each week to the small group of believers and unbelievers who attend our church's meetings. We recently finished studying Isaiah in our combined Sunday school class and started on 1 Peter, and Tom is nearing the end of the book of Revelation on Sunday mornings. Gabriella (she is currently the only one in our kids' class—that meets during the Sunday morning message) and I are working through the life of Christ. The Tuesday ladies' Bible study has been plodding slowly through Titus, and the book of Romans is the topic of study during our Thursday evening prayer meeting. We trust God's Word will continue to produce spiritual fruit in all of our lives.

Tom is still squaring away speakers while we are on furlough. Ilario will handle the majority of the preaching, but Tom is working to organize some other Italian contacts and missionaries to come in as special speakers.

The kids passed the flu around last week, but we are thankful that everyone recovered quickly.

Please continue to pray for the salvation of the people we have frequent contact with such as: **Alba, Alberto, Diego, Piera, Liliana, Manuela, Maria, Mario, Monaldo, Sandra, Simone, and Sonia.**
