**Thank you for your prayers for our church in Italy.** We've kept up with our people individually, and I have had 3 zoom Bible studies with the ladies. Ilario has been handling the bulk of the preaching on Sundays, though there have been a couple of special speakers, and several other people are involved in different aspects of the ministry. We trust God will use this time to grow them and us spiritually.

**Thank you for praying for Daniela's arm.** We took her to an orthopedic clinic in South Carolina, and she is healing well and delighted to be free of her immobilizer.

**Thank you for praying for our travels.** We actually arrived in Seattle (from Vancouver Island) on the day of the Seattle airport protests (April 15) and had quite a tough time maneuvering in the city by rental vehicle, bus, shuttle, and on foot with all our luggage in the sea of other displaced people. We even found and turned in (to the police on the street) someone's lost wallet and thankfully made it safely to the east coast. Tom continues to plan and navigate our travels and stops, and we have been privileged to enjoy some historical and beautiful sites.

**Thank you for praying for our administrative tasks.** I renewed my driver's license, and we got lots of things done in South Carolina. We had some complications with our rental vehicle, and after 1 stop to AutoZone, 2 to Firestone, and some calls to the rental agency, they switched out our vehicle in Glen Allen, VA, a week ago.

**Thank you for praying for our meetings.** We have been encouraged by the people of Trinity Bible Church (Greer, SC), Catawba Spiring Church Church (Apex, NC), College Park Baptist Church (Cary, NC), Hanover Baptist Church (Glen Allen, VA), and Cornwall Baptist Church (Cornwall, NY). As we travel, we really enjoy getting to know you all better. We hear of your many burdens, struggles, and joys, and we pray as we weep with those of you who weep and rejoice with those of you who rejoice. In addition to personal struggles, some churches as a whole are going through transitions or difficulties. **Please pray with us for the churches that are going through tough times or looking for new pastors.**

After the morning service this past Sunday (which was conducted in Spanish and English), Tom had the opportunity to give the gospel in Italian to a woman and her daughter who were invited by her husband's employee. **Please pray for her and her daughter, and for the gentleman's continued witness to this Italian family.**

We will be meeting with 6 churches this coming month. **Please continue to pray for safety, health, and spiritual fruit as we travel.**
