Thank you for your prayers for my trip to visit my grandma and uncle. My uncle is still in the hospital, and my grandma isn't doing too well either. I'm thankful for the opportunity to be with them and to be a help to them. Sadly, they maintain that we have been brainwashed (on spiritual matters).

The kids and I spent a lot of hours (over several days) helping a family in our church clear all the pruned branches from their olive grove—sorting the firewood to save and burning the brush. It was a lot of work, but we enjoyed the time together working, chatting, making fires, and cooking things (apples, potatoes, and chestnuts) in the embers. Tom and Simone (unbeliever) installed speakers in our church building and worked for two days to install an electric gate for a family.

Besides talking with people while serving them, Tom has had some counseling opportunities with several who attend our church. He also had an open door with the plumber that came to fix our hot water tank. I met with a neighbor (Sonia) for coffee. We've given tracts to several people, including a couple who used to work at the US embassy in Rome. Danilo (one of the young men in our church) spent a few days in the hospital and witnessed to his roommate there. His mom also spent some time in the hospital and witnessed to her roommate. Both have contact information for following up. Ilario has been helping with a prison ministry as he has time and will be distributing calendars there for Christmas. There have been other opportunities—and will be more, particularly with Christmas approaching. **We praise God for the interest among some of our people to evangelize and pray for spiritual fruit in the people of Deruta.**

Our ladies' **Christmas party will be December 1, and Isabella will give the devotional.** The next meeting with our young people to discuss the book they are reading on corporate worship will be **December 5.**
