Dear Friends,

The Bible Institute will meet again Friday and Saturday (March 20 & 21). They will be discussing finances in the "Serving in the church" class and integrity and lying in the Ethics class. **Please pray for Tom and Jon as they teach and for the students to understand and apply the material.**

Daniela will have a follow-up appointment with the orthodontist March 26. We are still **praying for the tooth (that is stuck up in her gums) to come down on it's own.**

Since Nino is in his last year of middle school (homeschooled), **he is required to face additional testing** at the public school. We do yet have the dates for these extra tests, but they will be in April.

A Brazilian family visited our church two weeks ago. They have been in Italy only 2 months and are learning Italian. While this makes for an interesting dynamic in the children's class (their 5-year-old son doesn't speak Italian), we are **praying for them to come again.**

The men in our church, though few, have been participating more in ministries. The young people who still attend our church seem eager to serve and to grow spiritually. The women, the largest group in our church, are the most varied in their needs and desires and growth. The vast majority have unsaved husbands or are single.

This past week marked the annual visit of the local priest to bless people's houses. Italy is by and large a post-religious country, but superstitions like the blessing of the houses reminds us of the grip the Roman Catholic Church continues to have on the everyday lives of people here.

Please continue to **pray for our faithfulness in evangelism and for spiritual fruit in our friends, neighbors, and children.**
