Dear Friends,

We hope you had a wonderful Easter, celebrating the resurrection of our Savior. We had a special Good Friday service with communion, and after our Easter Sunday service, we had lunch together. We did not have any first-time visitors, and our attendance was down, but we enjoyed the time to worship and fellowship together.

The Bible Institute will meet Friday and Saturday (April 17 & 18). They will be discussing evangelism, prayer, visitation, and conflict resolution in the "Serving in the church" class and theft in the Ethics class. We made a couple of changes to the room this month. Tom put up blinds on the glass doors to help block the summer heat, and I made curtains for the windows to help mask the distractions outside the building. **Please pray for Tom and Jon as they teach and for the students to understand and apply the material.**

Nino took the second of three exams at the middle school today. These exams are preparatory exams for the ones he will have in June (along with Angelo). Tom met with the high school that will be managing Daniela's exams this year (in August), and we thank God that they gave helpful guidance.

The Brazilian family has not returned to church, but a woman from Cameroon has been coming (on the Sundays she does not work) for a few months now. She has health struggles, and her family needs to be saved. Several ladies who attend our church have unsaved husbands. **Please pray these women and their husbands: Anna, Elisabetta, Elena, Gemma, Olga, Siena, Silvia, and Iolanda.** Unfortunately, Olga's husband hasn't been allowing her to worship with us for the last couple of weeks.

Tom continues to meet with our young people about once a month to discuss the book they are reading (currently about God's sovereignty) and other times for games and fellowship. **Some of them have important decisions to make and are asking God for wisdom. Diego and Monaldo (two young men who no longer come to church) need to accept Christ as their Savior.**

I will be helping out with crafts for VBS at a different church in June, and Tom has been helping me work through some of the planning and preparation.

Please continue to **pray for our faithfulness in evangelism and for spiritual fruit in our friends, neighbors, and children.**
